Since 1988, Rotary’s efforts, along with the World Health Organization, The Centers for Disease Control and governments around the world, have achieved a 99 percent reduction in the number of polio cases worldwide. To date, Rotarians have contributed over a billion dollars plus millions of hours as Rotary Volunteers, doing service work in our third world countries.

### International Humanitarian Projects

These projects raise the standard of living in both our communities and internationally by improving health, literacy levels, and water quality, giving impetus for agricultural, social and economic development where it is most needed.

### Educational Programs
